

**Faculty Positions Open at KAUST

KING ABDULLAH UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (KAUST) invites applications for faculty positions in Environmental Science and Engineering (EnSE) at the new campus in Saudi Arabia. The principal area of research interest is Environmental Hydrology and Fluid Mechanics, with specific possible focus areas including groundwater hydrology, contaminant hydrology, arid-lands hydrology, managed aquifer recharge, and/or hydrodynamic water quality modeling. Teaching interests may fall within groundwater hydrology, surface water hydrology, arid-lands hydrology, and/or modeling of environmental transport processes. The rank is open at all levels ranging from assistant to full professor.

KAUST (<http://www.kaust.edu.sa>) is a new international, graduate-level research university dedicated to inspiring a new age of scientific achievement in the Kingdom, the region, and the world.
