Post Doctoral Position in C and N Cycling at the Bureau of Economic Geology, Jackson School of Geosciences, University of Texas at Austin

We have an opening for a post doctoral fellow focusing on carbon and nitrogen cycling for one year with possible extension for a second year upon

mutual consent/agreement. Half of the time will focus on impacts of conversion from natural ecosystems to agroecosystems in the Texas High Plains on nitrogen cycling and effects on groundwater contamination in the High Plains aquifer. The other half of the time is open to working on general issues related to carbon and nitrogen cycling that can include modeling analyses, international work, or other topics depending on the expertise and interest of the applicant. Hydrologists, agronomists, ecologists and others with a background on C and N cycling are welcome to apply. This work will be conducted within the Center for Sustainable Water Resources.
